



Walls

Walls A-E are the same walls used for Emmigrants in the same position on stage as used for Emmigrants. Build Walls F and G, shown above connected to Wall B in the same fashion.


All Walls are to look like poured concrete basement walls in an old building. Use cement board facing for walls-both sides on WA and WE. Hide straight seams/cracks. Paint to age and simulate poured concrete.

Walls Scale: 1/2"=1'-0"





SECTION A-A SCALE 1/2'' = 1'-0''





Mirror Panel M I 2" thick frame is filled with breakable mirror material. Framing should be 1x2 on edge.

Script calls for actor to be pressed into mirror until it shatters. Please consult designer for solutions that are affordable.

Panel cleats onto molding for easy placement and removal. Note that Mirror panel is removed and reset during show replaced by fabric panel P3.

Molding is placed onto wall to hide holes from emmigrants pipe unistrut and for decorative purposes. It also serves as cleating surface for fabric and mirror panel
